## Minutes of Club Meeting held February 3, 2010

Members present: Gordon Wankier, Rod Cross, Kellee Johnson, Gene Davids, Lyle Lambert, Larry Taylor, Ron Weaver, Vern Hutchens, Randy Shikashio, Mike Curnutt, and Chris Jenneiahn.

The meeting was called to order at 7PM by president, Gordon Wankier. He reported that at the annual Board of Directors' meeting in January, all members of the board said they would continue on the board for the 2010 year. The annual budget was reviewed. Our total income, annually, is approximately \$20,000. Our expenditures to operate amount to approximately \$12,000. This allows us the difference to budget for repair, maintenance, and improvement for the Gun Club. This year's main project will be the upper range. A 90 foot by 12 foot slab needs to be poured, similar to what is on the lower range. Posts need to be installed for the covering, again, similar to the lower range. Repair is needed on the roadway to the upper range. Since gravel alone does not seem to hold, road mix is being suggested. A bid is needed for this. Two bids have already been received on the work to be done on the upper range and another bid should be in shortly. Building on the upper range is scheduled, tentatively, to begin in March. The web site for the gun club needs to be updated and kept current. Mike Curnutt and Nate Satterthwaite will work with Randy Shikashio to work on this project.

Our first project for the year will be the 1st weekend in May. It is the annual Highway and Club Clean-Up Day. Last year we had lots of participation and things were quickly done. If you have signed up to help with this project you will be called a couple of weeks before to remind you. Bring rakes, shovels, gas weed eaters, gloves, cleaning supplies, etc. for helping that day.

There are several special days this year. Again, the annual Sight In Day, the 4th Saturday of September, will also need help. Tell your friends that that's the day they can come to the range and sight in their rifles for no fee. There will be people to help when needed.

Mike Adams has stepped up to be the lead person for mowing the range this year. If you have volunteered to mow, Mike or Chris will be contacting you so you know how the lawn tractor works, what needs checking before and after use, and any other things that need to be learned.

The Sporting Clays Annual event has now been officially scheduled for the weekend of July 10th. It will be a 3 day shoot. More information on this will be announced in upcoming newsletters. Ron Stoutmeyer will head this fun event.

Gene Davids and Ron Weaver head up the Black Powder Cartridge matches that are held the 3rd Saturday of the month. If you don't shoot this event but would like to see how it's run, come out and watch. They'd love an audience. Larry Taylor told us about the Johnny Appleseed shoot to be held later in the year, probably early fall. The cost is about \$70 for lots of hands on instruction from qualified people.

Discussion was held on possibly giving awards of some kind for 5 stand, trap, and black powder cartridge high scorers during the shooting season. This will have to be discussed more to see how this can be done fairly.

Mention of the various groups' annual banquet/dinners/auctions was made. There are lots of opportunities to support whatever species you prefer. The meeting was adjourned at 7:30
